speechBITE is a **FREE** searchable database providing access and appraisal of intervention research in SLP. There are over 5100 research articles which we have found for you by searching multiple online databases (e.g; Medline, PsycINFO). We only list treatment research relevant to SPs and the database is updated monthly, so you can be sure you have access to the latest pre-appraised evidence.

### Learn how to rate the methodological quality of research articles

speechBITE uses the PEDro-P scale to rate the methodological quality of group studies ( randomised and non-randomised controlled trials). speechBITE has a free online training program to teach SPs how to use the PEDro-P scale, find out more [here](#).
